☐ 4. Instruction packet letter (Email with interview date on) received from call center, NVC, or the U.S. embassy
☐ 5. DS 260(Immigrant or Diversity VISA) confirmation page or DS160 (K1 VISA) confirmation page
(Not applicable for those handing the results to military base)
 6. Vaccination records (including a baby care notebook) & Antibody blood test report (If available) The immunization record must be a certified document with doctor's name, doctor's signature/license number or hospital name, and hospital seal. Please be sure to bring all your vaccination documents. (If vaccination is needed, it will be prescribed by the doctor on the day of the examination.)
 Without immunization records or antibody results, it is

considered as unvaccinated.
